Visit Baxter's for a tour of the winery and vineyards. Enjoy free wine tasting and Carol's pies. Light and easy walking through vineyards and apple orchards.

This trip will involve light and easy walking on a mowed paths through the vineyards and apple orchards. Walking distance should be less than ½ mile.

Baxter's Vineyards is a small family-owned winery in Nauvoo, Illinois. The winery was established in 1857 by Emile Baxter and continues in the family. Kelly Logan is the fifth generation Baxter to grow grapes and apples. He and his wife Brenda are still producing and bottling Baxter's Old Nauvoo Brand wines.
